Champagnes

- 002 Pierre Sparr, Cremant de Alsace Brut Rose**
Haut-Rhin (France) **\$ 55**
This wine has aromas of red berries, the Flavors are intense on the palate with a Lively acidity and a clean , dry and smooth Finish.
- 010 Jean Comyn, Harmonie Brut**
Mont Saint-Pere, Champagne (France) **\$68**
Has a lovely light style with a touch of toast And brioche on the nose. With a fresh and lovely palate that has some notes of lemon/lime Well rounded finish.
- 003 Brut Non-Vintage, Moët & Chandon**
Champagne (France) **\$ 85**
Glass: \$ 16
Lovely citrus nose that shows hints of White flowers, minerals and brioche. It is Smooth textured with graceful structure and Bright acidity.
- 004 Brut Non-Vintage, Laurent Perrier**
Champagne (France) **\$ 105**
Pale Golden hue color with fine and persistent Bubbles. The nose is fresh and delicate, showing good complexity with hints of citrus And white fruit. Dry, light, Crisp and elegant.
- 005 Brut Non-Vintage, Veuve Clicquot**

Offers both fresh and fragrant fruit as well as Richness, a soft creamy texture and bright Acidity with a lightly smoky finish.

Deep golden hue, with an intense range of Aromas, such as dried fruit, almonds and Hazelnut with grilled and toasted hints. Uses Sweetness to bring up the fruit flavors.

Tempranillo, Garnacha and Mazuelo Blend Bright ruby red color, soft, rich and long On the palate. Spicy and Balsamic aromas on The nose.

Tempranillo with plenty of lush berry and Cassis fruit. With Floral Bouquet, this medium Bodied wine shows hints of vanilla , black Currant and some oak.

100% Sauvignon Blanc, 100%Hand harvested Intense and complex on the nose with floral, Fruit and some ginger notes. A hint of vanilla On the palate with a full and intense finish.
